

Creating an Inspection Template

Learn how to create an inspection template on the desktop.

1. Log in to **Quore** on the desktop.



2. Click on the **App Switcher**.




3. Select Inspections.









4. Click Templates.



5. From the **Templates** page, click the **+ icon**.



6. Next, enter the template details on the **Create Templat**e page.









7. Select the department who will use this inspection in the **Used by** field.



8. Select the **Frequency**.




9. You can also use the **Reminder** section to receive an alert in your **To Do List** before the due date.








10. Select Yes from the Show Rooms dropdown to add a rooms grid to your Inspection or Checklist.



11. When you are done, click **Create Template**.




12. To complete the creation process, on the next page begin to build your template by entering a step in the text box. Click anywhere to save.









13. Choose a department for a task to go to if the step is failed.



14. Assign point values to each step in the **Points** field.




15. Mark the step as **Required** or leave this box unchecked to make it not required. Select **Default to Pass** if you want the step to be pre-checked. **Default to Pass** steps cannot be marked as required.









16. Click the ellipsis (three dots) beside the step to Edit, Duplicate, or Delete the step.



17. Click **Add Category** to create categories for your steps to go into. Type in the category name. Click anywhere to save automatically.




18. Click the ellipsis (three dots) beside a category to **Add a Subcategory** if desired. Click anywhere to save.







19. After clicking the ellipsis (three dots), you will see all options found within the category.



20. Continue adding steps until the template is complete. Navigate back to the **Templates** page in the **Inspections app** to view and edit your template.
